### Efficiency

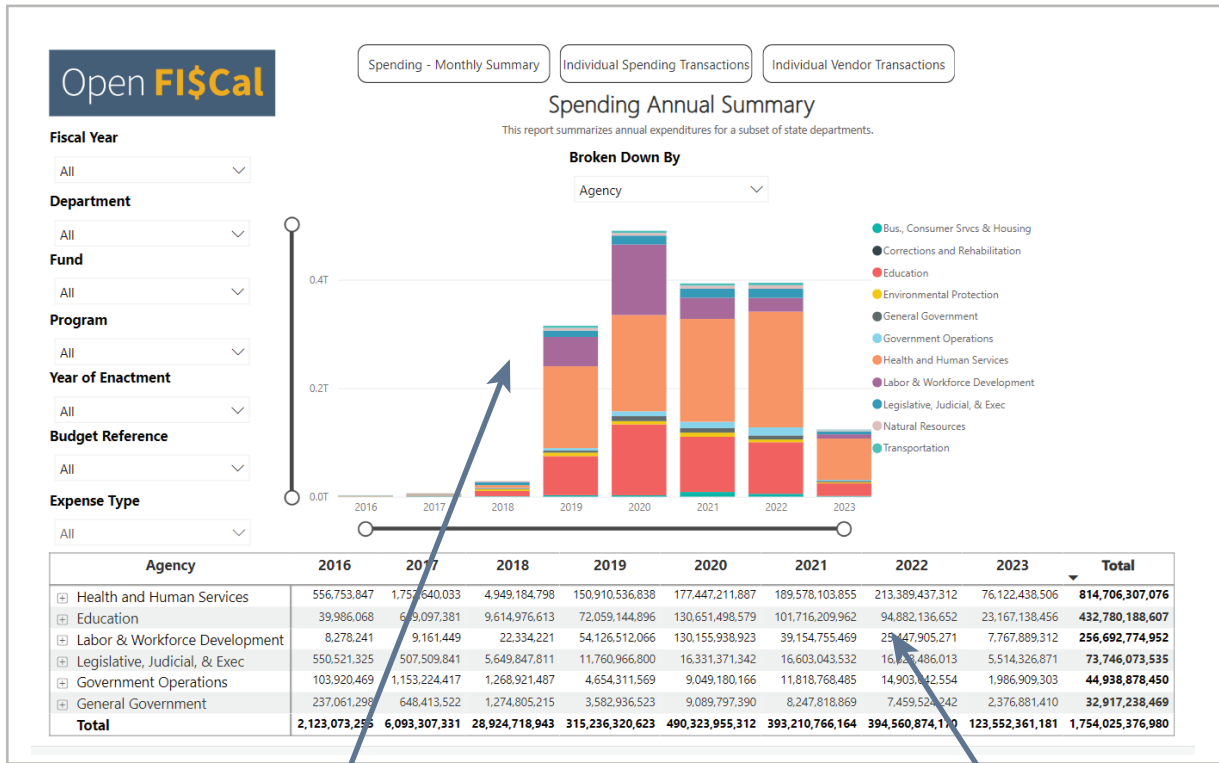
Open financial data reduces transaction costs for sharing data within government and empowers citizens to alert government to data gaps and inaccuracies

- Pilot site went live in September 2018 with data from a few departments
- The site now contains data from all departments in the system starting in fiscal year 2019-20
- In March 2020, the site added a Learning Center to help members of the public better use and understand the data on the site

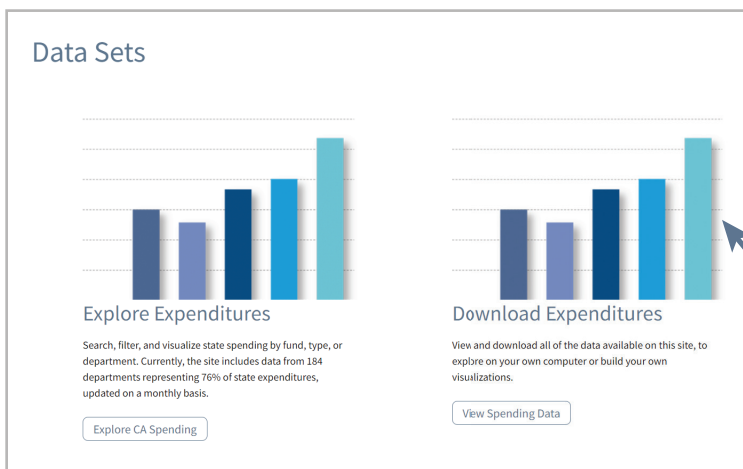
## Site Features
