### Transparency

Open financial data provides a new opportunity for governments to collaborate with citizens on improving public services, and for entrepreneurs to understand markets and build new data-driven tools



### Efficiency


Open financial data reduces transaction costs for sharing data within government and empowers citizens to alert government to data gaps and inaccuracies

## Progress

- Pilot site went live in September 2018 with data from a few departments
- The site now contains data from all departments in the system starting in fiscal year 2019-20
- As of August 11, 2023, the Open FI\$Cal downloadable data site is enhanced with an in-house Power BI transparency report and an Azure-based file storage where expenditure data is available for download.


## Site Features
